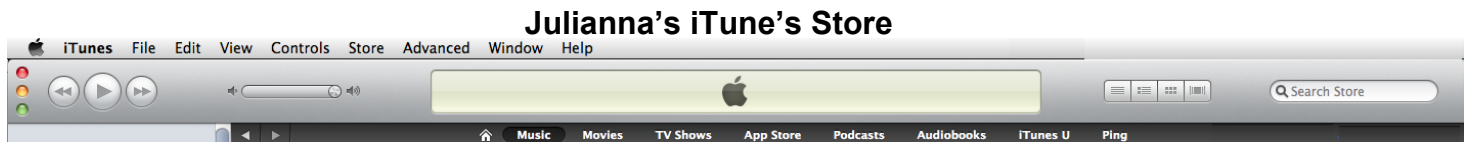

For the Raiders of the Lost Ark there's only one word to sum it all up is AMAZING! I can't get enough there's so much going on between the trumpets and the drums, PERFECT! This song is by far the best he has ever written. It wasn't repetitive, perfectly loud and it's choppy the best to listen to whenever a bit of romance at the end for the toppings.
